Purpose

Coburg High School focuses on a holistic concept of health and hygiene. It recognises the importance of creating an environment that is hygienic; this ensures the safety of not only the students and staff but their families, the wider community and our public health systems. Using best evidence-based health and hygiene practices, Coburg High School identifies that this policy is a shared responsibility involving the combined efforts of many. Coburg High School's values are: Excellence, Integrity, Curiosity and community. This policy was written with these values in mind.

Objective

This policy aims to provide guidelines for procedures to be implemented at Coburg High School to:

- Ensure all students and staff maintain their health.
- Help students manage their own personal hygiene routines.
- Minimise the risk of infection while at school.
- Provide a safe, clean and hygienic learning environment.

Scope

This policy applies to staff, students, families and carers.

Definitions

Hand Hygiene (HH) is a general term referring to any action of hand cleansing. It includes: handwashing with soap and water and the use of antimicrobial hand rubs; for example an alcohol-based hand rub.

Handwashing is the action of washing hands with plain soap and water for 20 seconds or longer.



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Antiseptic hand rubbing (or hand rubbing) is the action of applying an antiseptic hand rub to reduce or inhibit the growth of microorganisms without the need for water.

Personal hygiene is the action, habit or practice of keeping oneself clean, especially as a means of maintaining good health. The practice of personal hygiene can also protect the health of others.

Menstrual hygiene management (MHM) is a necessary aspect of hygiene for those who menstruate for a significant period of their lives. MHM describes the practice of using clean materials to absorb/collect menstrual blood that can be changed in privacy as often as necessary when individuals have their menstrual period.

Infectious Diseases are caused by pathogenic microorganisms, such as bacteria, viruses, parasites or fungi; the diseases can be spread, directly or indirectly, from one person to another.

Environmental cleaning is the action of using adequate procedures for the routine cleaning and disinfection of environmental and other frequently touched surfaces .

Respiratory Hygiene is the action of covering the nose and mouth when coughing/sneezing with a tissue or mask, disposing of used tissues and masks, and performing hand hygiene after contact with respiratory secretions.

Cough Etiquette: is the action of covering the mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing. Best practice when sneezing/ coughing is to use the inner elbow or use a tissue to cover the mouth and nose discarding of tissues into a bin, then cleaning hands with soap and water or a disinfectant hand rub.

Oral Hygiene: Good oral hygiene includes regular brushing, flossing and dental appointments.

Policy STRATEGIES AND ACTIONS

HAND HYGIENE

Coburg High School shall	 Ensure standard precautions for infection control are met. Train staff in these procedures and have appropriate material and equipment available. Display infection control & hand hygiene posters in all bathrooms & throughout the school. Provide handwashing stations including consumables like, soap (via a dispenser) a method for hand drying and an alcohol based hand rub.
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	(<u>Personal Hygiene</u>)
Coburg High School Staff shall	Educate and encourage students in good personal hygiene practices including but not limited to hand hygiene and/or hand sanitisation for 20 seconds or longer:
Coburg High School Students shall	Follow guidelines set out by CHS and staff, which include but are not limited to frequently washing their hands for 20 seconds or longer.
Coburg High School Parents/ Carers shall	Encourage students to frequently maintain good hand hygiene at home and at school.

PERSONAL HYGIENE - BODY ODOR & ORAL HYGIENE

Coburg High School shall	 Provide educational material to students. Provide some hygiene products upon request. e.g deodorant and soap.
Coburg High School Staff shall	 Provide education around good personal hygiene in a classroom setting. Practice good personal hygiene.
Coburg High School Students shall	Practice good hygiene, including but not limited to showering, brushing of hair and teeth and applying deodorant.
Coburg High School Parents/ Carers shall	Encourage their children to maintain good hygiene practices at home.

MENSTRUAL HYGIENE

C	oburg High School shall	The Victorian Government has allowed the provision of free sanitary pads and tampons in school with the aim of:



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	 Providing students with the confidence that there will always be sanitary items available at school Relieving students of the stigma, anxiety and discomfort that can be associated with menstruation and its management so they can focus on their studies Easing the cost of living for families. Pads and tampons are available at the School First Aid Office and in some female bathrooms (x2) & reception & SST. (FREE SANITARY PADS AND TAMPONS IN ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS)
Coburg High School Staff shall	 Promote a positive social environment, having open discussions about the safest way to use sanitary products. This will help build positive social norms and help young people to manage their menstrual hygiene with dignity and comfort. Education will be provided through the curriculum in a classroom setting. Coburg High School has a Health Promotion Nurse on campus two days a week who is available by appointment for any students or staff that wish to be provided with further information. (Promoting Positive Menstrual Health in Schools) & (Personal Hygiene)
Coburg High School Students shall	Be aware of the importance of menstrual hygiene.
Coburg High School Parents/ Carers shall	Be aware of the importance of menstrual hygiene.

RESPIRATORY HYGIENE & COUGH ETIQUETTE

Coburg High School shall	Provide and display information around the school from the Victorian Department of Health and Human Services recommended best practices.
Coburg High School Staff shall	 Encourage and teach students about the best practices when it comes to respiratory hygiene & cough etiquette. Refer to definition; Cough Etiquette. Cover mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing. Practicing hand hygiene after contact with respiratory secretions.
Coburg High School Students shall	 Cover mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing. Practice hand hygiene after contact with respiratory



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	secretions. (<u>Standard Precautions in Healthcare</u>)
Coburg High School Parents/	Help remind children/child of the importance of respiratory
Carers shall	hygiene and cough etiquette.

Coburg High School Parents/ Carers shall	Return the borrow uniform after it has been cleaned.
